- All grain must be grown during the previous season.
- If grain has to be treated for weevil, this must be done at least three weeks prior to the Show.
- All exhibits must be clearly display their exhibit ticket.
- All grains will be tested with Viterra protein testing machine. Points score on protein, screenings and weight will apply.
- All grain to be taken direct from header and not cleaned.
- Wheat which, in the opinion of the judges has been pickled, mill dressed or from which the brush is absent will be disqualified.
- Classes marked \* are eligible to compete for the MLASA Trophy as per Rule 30.
