Demonstrating leadership and inclusion, with commitment to innovation and technology, the Riverland Wine Show has balance in age, gender and region, as well as using state-of-the-art judging software and strict judging criteria. - All sheep exhibited must have a handler present during judging
  - Rams to be owned by Exhibitor for at least one year
  - Sheep from OJD map program properties will be penned separately from non-assessed sheep
  - All sheep to be full wool unless otherwise stated
  - No entry shall be entered in more than one class unless specified
  - Entries must be presented with your **NVD** form, Sheep Health Statement and **Animal waiver form**
  - Class numbers marked \* are eligible to compete for the MLASA Trophy \$30 in accord with Rule 30
  - Entry fee includes 30c premium for public liability insurance
  - For trophies, first counts as 2 points and second as 1 point
  - Winners of Championship Classes in Sheep Section to be one year and over
  - Eligible for **H.E. KROEHN MEMORIAL TROPHY only from Classes : Sheep 1-16; Wool 1-8**
